Standards for the exhibitor:

- 1. To understand and demonstrate a wardrobe plan.
- 2. To understand how selected garment(s) and accessories enhance their personal/public presentation.
- 3. To understand the value of this garment/outfit/exhibit and how it fits into the family's clothing budget.
- 4. To be able to describe how they have accepted personal responsibility in caring for their garment/outfit/exhibit.
- 5. To visually demonstrate personal fitness and grooming and clothing/accessories comfort and safety.
- 6. To be able to describe how they have cared for the garment/outfit/exhibit, how it fits into their wardrobe plan and describe/demonstrate clothing project skills gained during the year.
