



# 2018 BREAD SCULPTURES County Contest

“Find Your Fun” and have fun with your food. Get your hands on some dough and enter our County Contest. This year, we combine: wheat, one of the great agricultural products in Kansas, creativity, various shaping techniques and baking. Come join in and “WOW” us with your creation. Your “Find Your Fun” journey begins at your county fair and can take you to the Kansas State Fair.



## RULES:

- ❖ The Atchison County Fair Contest is open to all residents. Limit 3 entries per participant, per class. Limit one award.
- ❖ Bread sculpture may be constructed from frozen yeast dough or a yeast dough made from scratch. Bread sculptures will not be tasted. Seeds, herbs and other edible decorative toppings and icings may be used. No size restrictions. For small individual sculptures, 6 should be entered. - ❖ Must submit a typed, detailed recipe including shaping instructions with step by step photos or sketches on an 8 1/2" x 11" paper with name and address in lower left corner (will be covered prior to judging). Include age for youth entries.
- ❖ All sculptures must be received on a sturdy, disposable plate, board, or tray and will remain on display throughout the fair.
- ❖ 4-H/Scout/FFA entries will be judged on Monday, August 6; must be entered by noon. Adult/Team/ General Youth may be entered on Tuesday, August 7 from 9:00 to 11:30 a.m. in the Blue Building.

Extended receiving hours for this contest only, Friday, September 7, between 8:00 a.m. - 11:00 a.m. Items may still be brought during standard receiving times for Foods entries earlier in the week. Premiums awarded in each class at the Kansas State Fair: 1st - \$50, 2nd - \$25 and 3rd - \$15. All premiums for this contest awarded during the Kansas State Fair will be paid directly from Kansas Wheat after the fair. One Overall Grand Champion at the Kansas State Fair will be selected from the (6) 1st place winners (County and Open Class winners) and will receive an additional \$100.
