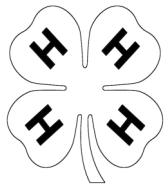

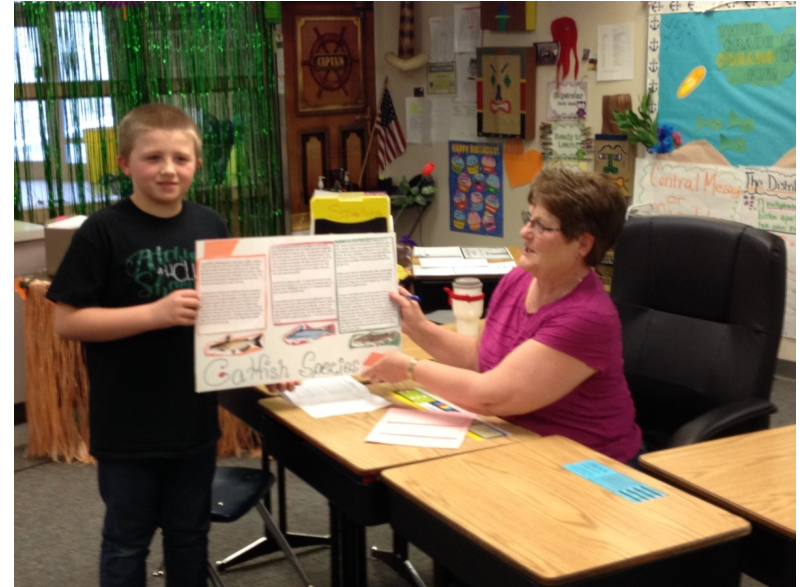

## Ribbons and County Day

- 4-Hers participating in events at 4-H Day are judged against a standard rather than being compared to fellow 4-Hers.
- Every 4-Her receives a ribbon. Participation certificates are presented to 4-Hers presenting FYI talks.
- As 4-H focuses on *Making the Best, Better*; it is helpful to understand the 4-H ribbon system.

**Green Ribbon:** This presentation is presented to recognize participation by the 4-Her. FYI talks are not judged but provide an opportunity to become comfortable giving a public presentation.

**White Ribbon:** Presentation meets minimum standards but there are several ways that the 4-Her might improve the presentation such as practicing more before giving a public presentation. It does not mean the presentation is not worthwhile.

**Red Ribbon:** Indicates an average presentation for the age of the youth. A member should feel proud when a red ribbon is presented and realize there are visible signs of needed improvement.

**Blue Ribbon:** Indicates quality work by the 4-H member. The presentation skills are considered to be above average for the age and experience of the member. Presentations selected for Regional Day receive a “Top Blue”. Following the 4-H motto of *Making The Best, Better*, this ribbon indicates the 4-Her has met established public speaking goals and is ready to seek new challenges.

Parents and 4-H leaders are encouraged to help members understand the ribbon system and how the judge’s evaluation offers tips to improve future work. Your support of the 4-H ribbon placing system encourages personal growth of the member.

## Answers To Your Club Day Questions

Original sheet music is required for all music entries. Judge will need music during judging. Mark and number measures on judges' music. Groups perform 2 numbers; solos 1 number.

Public speaking entries require an outline. A copy machine will **not** be available.

Easels and tables will be furnished. All other equipment is your responsibility.

Club secretary will need to turn in an up-to-date secretary's notebook and model meeting notes. Parliamentary problems will be provided 10 minutes prior to judging.

FYI talks do not require an introduction, conclusion or posters. However, 4-Her may do so if desired.

Final results will be announced at the assembly when all presentations are completed.

## Age Guidelines for County 4-H Day

*We understand that 4-H age guidelines can be confusing; so do ask if you have questions. Thank you for your understanding.*

<b>Demonstrations</b>	To conform with Regional 4-H Day Guidelines, 4-Hers who are 14 as of January 1 will be considered Seniors in the Demonstration Division.
<b>Impromptu</b>	<b>Suggested</b> age 9 and older
<b>Project Talks</b>	Any 4-Her 12 and younger may present a project talk.
<b>Public Speaking</b>	Designed to assist more experienced 4-Hers to improve their speaking skills. Need not be 4-H related.

## Helpful Tips for the Day

Check the time you are scheduled to perform. Please honor this time as both early and late entries create scheduling problems for the day.

4-Hers are assigned to their division by 4-H age. This age is based on age as of January 1.

If you need to cancel, notify your club leader and extension staff. Please contact the person in charge of the event of your cancellation.

When you arrive, check in with volunteer in charge of the division you are competing. Omissions or additional entries should be made at this time as well. Unlisted entries will be scheduled as time allows. ***4-Hers must check in by 9:30 or we cannot guarantee that you will be judged.***

If a schedule conflict occurs, inform the volunteer in charge of the division.

While events are in progress, **please do not open doors.**

4-Hers are encouraged to view the presentations of other 4-Hers.

Do help keep the building clean. We appreciate that we are able to use the school.

## 4-H Club Responsibilities Information

- Each club will need at least 1 to 2 volunteers to watch doors and introduce presentations.
- Arrive early enough to assist in arranging the room. Check folder for additional instructions.
- Have entrants fill out information on score sheets.
- Keep order in the room and halls. Doors should be closed when 4-Hers are performing.
- Announce each member and hand score sheet to judge.
- Turn in results to agents after the event is complete. Clean room.
